New TTD minimums take effect with increases in the minimum wage each July 1 but appear in the July 15 rate. The Illinois minimum wage increased to \$12.00 on January 1, 2022.

Effective 2/1/06, the maximum 8(d)1 (wage differential) award is equal to the SAWW, and the minimums are the same as the TTD minimums.
