New TTD minimums take effect with increases in the minimum wage each July 1 but appear in the July 15 rate. The Illinois minimum wage increased to \$14.00 on January 1, 2024.

Effective 2/1/06, the maximum 8(d)1 (wage differential) award is equal to the SAWW, and the minimums are the same as the TTD minimums.

\*\* If leg is amputated above the knee: 242 weeks. If leg is amputated at the hip and no artificial leg can be used, the employee is entitled to 296 weeks of compensation.

\*\*\* If eye is removed: 173 weeks.
